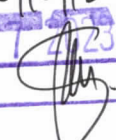

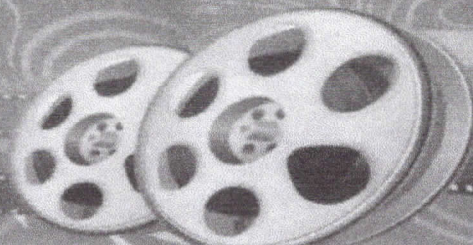
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ENTRY GUIDELINES

- The Short Film should raise awareness on the advocacy against Trafficking in Persons in our country.
- Must provide basic entry information (film maker's insights of the subject and its significance) and a film Title or Caption, on the entry forms.
- Contestants warrant that the film being submitted to the competition is original and owned by him/her.
- Short film must not have been published, posted, used, or submitted as an entry to other video contests.
- Short Film should be not less than 5 minutes and not more than 10 minutes.
- The short film should be in Visayan dialogue/script-writing – then subtitles will be provided after it has been selected.
- The contestant must submit his/her video and must follow this format:

"LAST NAME underscore FIRST NAME
underscore MOVIE TITLE.

i.e. "DELACRUZ_JUAN_LABANANANGTRAFFICKING"



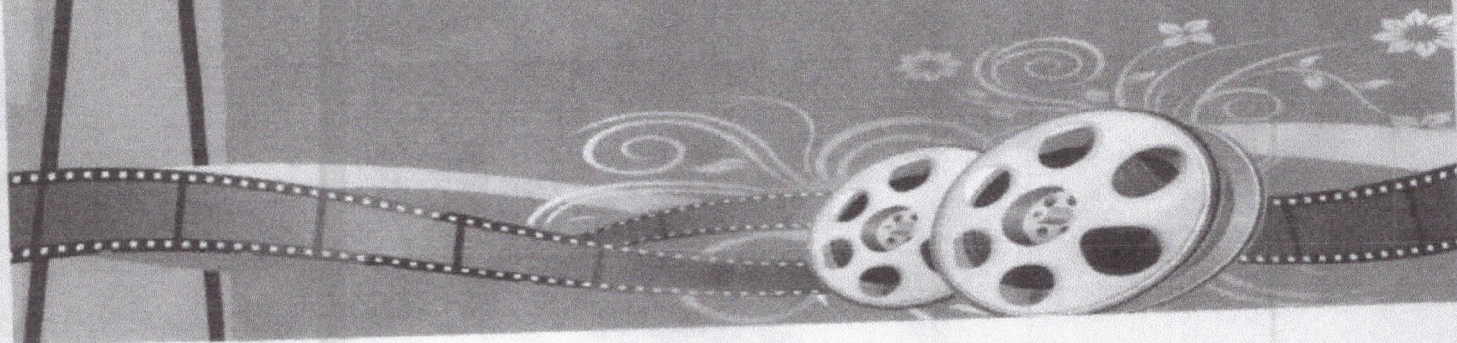

ENTRY GUIDELINES

- h. For video entries in which a person is recognizable, one must secure a model release from the subject or, in the case of a minor, the subject's parent or guardian and provide it upon submission of entry. Including the orientation of child protection policy in case of minors.
- i. No watermarking or digital mattes, frames, or borders allowed in the videos submitted.
- j. Film maker's name should not be visible on video so that the entries will be judged based solely on the film without biases or distractions.
- k. The contestant hereby grants the IACAT XI Network all rights, title and interest, including the copyright and all intellectual property rights, in and to the videos being submitted to the Competition and has the right to distribute, exhibit and promote the images in or through all media formats now known or hereafter devised, including, but not limited to, the Internet throughout the universe.
- l. During the contest period, all contestants must refrain from posting in social media the entries submitted;

m. The contestant guarantees that no material in the images being submitted to the Competition is libelous or is slanderous or defamatory or violates any right of privacy or publicity of any person, and the full use of the rights in such images will not violate any rights, including copyright or moral rights, of any person, firm, or corporation.
