SUBJECT : PEACEFUL AND SAFE OBSERVANCE OF UNDAS 2023

DATE : OCT 20, 2023

1. Background

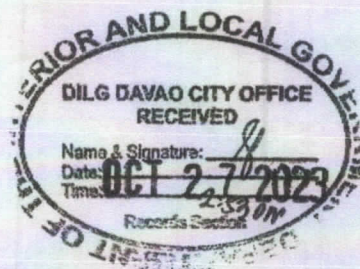
- 1.1. UNDAS is an annual opportunity of commemorating and praying for the departed souls of deceased loved ones of Filipinos. It is usually celebrated every 1st of November annually, which is a special (non-working) day.
- 1.2. For year 2023, November 2, 2023 was also declared as an additional special (non-working) day, pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 42.¹
- 1.3. Moreover, in view of the conduct of the Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan Elections (BSKE), October 30, 2023 was also declared as special non-working day, pursuant to Proclamation No. 359.²
- 1.4. In view of the dates of the scheduled non-working days, people are expected to take week-long holidays. Influx of people, as they are to travel to and from different regions in the country, is also expected especially that the state of public health emergency due to COVID-19 has been lifted, pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 267.³
- 1.5. Consistent with Section 16, Chapter II, Title One of Republic Act No. 7160, also known as the Local Government Code of 1991, local government units (LGUs) are responsible to ensure peace and order of their constituents, to

safeguard the welfare and safety of the community, and to promote resilient and inclusive communities.

2. Purpose

The purpose of this Memorandum Circular is to enjoin all Local Government Units (LGUs) to ensure the peaceful and safe observance of UNDAS 2023.

3. Scope/Coverage

All provinces, cities, municipalities, and barangays, DILG Regional and Field Offices; Chiefs of the Philippine National Police, Bureau of Fire Protection, Bureau of Jail Penology and Management; and all other offices concerned

4. Policy Content and Guidelines

- 4.1. All Local Chief Executives (LCEs) are directed to implement activities that will ensure a safe and peaceful observance of UNDAS 2023 such as, but not limited to the following:
 - 4.1.1. Convene the Local Peace and Order Council (LPOC), for action planning, anticipating, and preparing for the heavy movement and security of people in the public and private cemeteries and memorial parks within their areas of responsibility;
 - 4.1.2. Identify and assess any potential risks and hazards in the public and private cemeteries and memorial parks;
 - 4.1.3. Cause the mobilization and deployment of law and traffic enforcers, barangay tanods, Barangay Peacekeeping Action Teams (BPATs), public safety forces, medical personnel, and other force multipliers around public and private cemeteries and memorial parks;
 - 4.1.4. Coordinate with their respective traffic management offices to ensure the seamless movement of traffic vehicles around public and private cemeteries and memorial parks;
 - 4.1.5. Establish extensive coordination with the police and emergency responders;
 - 4.1.6. Maintain the cleanliness and orderliness in cemeteries and other public places before, during, and after UNDAS 2023; and,
 - 4.1.7. Implement other necessary measures, as may deemed necessary and appropriate, to ensure peaceful and safe observance of UNDAS 2023.

- 4.2. The **Philippine National Police (PNP)** is expected to coordinate with, and provide necessary assistance to LGUs in ensuring the peaceful, orderly, and safe observance of **UNDAS 2023**, by conducting activities such as, but not limited to, the following:

4.2.1. Increase police visibility within the public and private cemeteries and memorial parks, and where heavy movement of people is expected; and,

4.2.2. Establish police help desks within the abovesaid areas.

- 4.3. The **Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP)** and the **Bureau of Jail Penology and Management (BJMP)** are also expected to coordinate with, and provide necessary support to the LGUs and the PNP in responding to emergency situation/s that may arise, and in addressing other public safety concerns.

- 4.4. All DILG Regional Directors are directed to cause the immediate and widest dissemination of the Memorandum Circular to all LGUs within their areas of responsibility.

5. Effectivity

This Memorandum Circular takes effect immediately.

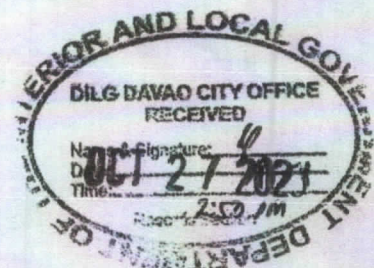
Pursuant to Section 3 of the Republic Act (RA) 7278, and RA 8044 or the Youth in Nation-Building Act, the Boys Scouts of the Philippines is mandated *"to promote through organization and cooperation with other agencies, the ability of boys to do useful things for themselves and others, to train in scoutcraft, and to inculcate in them patriotism, civic consciousness and responsibility, courage, and self-reliance, discipline and kindred virtues and moral values, using the method which are in common use by boy scouts."* It recognizes the vital role of Filipino youth in nation-building, and helps mold boys and girls into socially conscious, morally educated, skill-tested, environmentally aware, and service-oriented citizens and leaders of the country, through various scouting programs, projects, and activities in the local, regional, national, and international levels.

The formation of the youth through the scouting movement is a potent and effective way to address the existing social malady caused by drugs and vices that corrupt many young individuals, especially boys. It also makes the youth active volunteers, community builders, disaster responders, and environmental warriors.

Related thereto, the BSP will be conducting the 18th National Scouts Jamboree on **December 11-17, 2023** at the Camp Pintados de Passi, City of Passi, Iloilo, with the theme: *"Youth Engagement: Sustaining Relevance and Strengthening Resilience."*

The event is conducted only every four (4) years and is expected to host at least 30,000 scouts and leaders nationwide, with at least 300 foreign scouts from neighboring countries in the Asia-Pacific Region. This year's jamboree aims to provide a progressive learning environment for scouts to enhance their full social, physical, intellectual, character, emotional, and spiritual potential as active citizens in making contributions to creating a better community.

In view of the foregoing, and with reference to DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2018-11¹, and upon the request of Honorable Dale B. Corvera, 2nd District Representative of the Province of Agusan and National President of the BSP, all Provincial Governors, City and Municipal Mayors, are encouraged to promote, support, and allow participation of qualified scouts and adult leaders from their local government units (LGUs), on official business, to the said activity.

The payment of applicable traveling expenses and reasonable registration fee, if any, to defray the cost of meals, and activity materials, per participant, may be authorized, chargeable against local government funds, in accordance with, and subject to: a) applicable limitations prescribed in COA Circular No. 2012-003, dated October 29, 2012, b) to the usual accounting and auditing requirements, c) to austerity measures, and d) to all pertinent laws, rules, and regulations.

Moreover, all DILG Regional Directors are hereby directed to cause the immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum Circular to all LGUs within their respective regional assignments.
