CC-PFB provides students with a theoretical foundation in public finance, local and national government budgeting, and the budget process, with emphasis on the role of the various stakeholders, and the significance and importance of the national and local budgets in governance and development.

Course Objectives

The course provides an overview of the fundamental principles and logic of government fiscal activities and government budgets.

Specifically, the course aims to:

- Discuss the fundamental theories, principles, and policies of public finance and budgeting;
- Be familiar with the central role and significance of the government budgets in attaining the objectives of government for the whole of society and economy;
- Examine current issues in public finance and budgeting;
- Learn and adopt the PFM reforms and new best practices in government budgeting, procurement, and managing the government's fiscal program;
- Identify innovation challenges to assist PFM stakeholders; and
- Contribute to the development of future systems, policies, and processes to enable effective public finance by adopting a futures thinking approach.
