1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 242, s. 2011, Celebration of the National Teachers' Month (NTM) and World Teachers' Day (WTD), all personnel are required to attend and join the Culmination Activity on October 4, 2024 (Friday) from 8:00am to 3:00 pm at the Digos City Gymnasium. Meanwhile, School-Based Celebration will be conducted on October 3, 2024.

2. The District / Private Schools will decide on what to wear during the activity. The SDO personnel shall wear MATATAG Polo Shirt.

Guidelines for the Yell Contest

1. **Objective:**

The contest aims to foster team spirit and showcase the creativity of teachers in highlighting their respective school district taglines through a dynamic yet minimal movement yell presentation.

2. **Participants:**

- All teachers in the district.

3. **Performance Duration:**

- The yell must not exceed **1 minute**.
- Timing begins when the group starts their performance and will be strictly enforced.

4. **Content:**

- The yell must emphasize the **school district's tagline**.
- The content should reflect pride in the district, unity, and teacher empowerment.
- All content should be appropriate for a professional setting and school environment.

5. **Movement:**

- The performance should involve **minimal movement**, such as hand gestures, facial expressions, and limited choreography.
- Overly complex dance routines are discouraged. The focus should be on vocal power, energy, and creativity in delivering the message.

6. **Creativity and Presentation:**

- Groups are encouraged to use creative elements such as vocal variations, chants, and harmonized cheers.
- Props are allowed but must be simple and not distract from the main yell.
- Costumes are optional but should align with the district's theme or color scheme.

7. **Judging Criteria:**

- **Adherence to Time Limit:** 10%
- **Clarity and Impact of Tagline:** 30%
- **Creativity and Presentation:** 30%
- **Energy and Enthusiasm:** 20%
- **Coordination and Group Dynamics:** 10%

8. **Prohibition:**

- Exceeding the time limit.
- Excessive movements or choreography.
- Inappropriate content or presentation.

9. **Awards:**

- Prizes will be awarded for **Best Yell, Most Creative Presentation, Most Enthusiastic Team, Most Organized District, and Best in Costume and Props**
