Subject : **LEARNING MODALITY IN LIGHT OF EXTREME HEAT INDEX WITHIN THE COUNTRY (PARTICULARLY IN DIGOS CITY)**

Date : April 11, 2024

In reference to DepEd Order No. 037 s. 2022, re: "*Guidelines on the Cancellation of or Suspension of Classes and Work in Schools in the Event of Natural Disasters, Power Outages/Power Interruptions, and Other Calamities*", DepEd Memorandum OUOPS No. 2024-04-02477, re: "*Mitigating Measures for Extreme Heat/EL Niño*", and in support to discussions concerning "extreme heat index experienced within the country nowadays" as highlighted during the latest Division MANCOM Meeting, this Office supports the "Conduct of Half-Day In-Person Classes and Half-Day Modular Distance Delivery or Asynchronous Learning" within April 15-19, 2024, which may be extended depending on assessment result concerning weather condition to be announced in a separate memorandum.

The said office support has considered the increase of cases of epistaxis or nosebleed experienced among the learners, which is possibly caused by the said "extreme heat index or escalating temperature. Thus, the continuous report of the Health and Nutrition Unit on this concern shall consistently be considered in the evaluation when deciding to either continue or conclude the above-mentioned class modality. If the weather allows, the school can choose to still conduct the whole day In-Person Classes.

Suggested/Proposed schemes on scheduling of classes (*for both single shift and double shifts*) for In-Person Classes are attached hereto. However, it is reiterated that School Heads are given the leeway to decide on class scheduling depending on school context. School Head and Teachers must discuss thoroughly how the said class modality be implemented where learning continues to happen effectively. Further, for asynchronous classes, it is expected that teachers will provide learners with activities that continuously ignite their interest and promote learning.

It is emphasized that parents/guardians, including the LGUs, shall be informed properly (in writing) of the class scheme that your school will undergo.

In the implementation of the "Half-Day In-Person Classes and Half-Day Modular Distance Delivery or Asynchronous Learning", teachers are expected to still render the required number of hours as per DepEd existing guidelines and CSC rules.
