- **Support Policy Development:** Provide insights and recommendations for science and technology policies that can propel regional growth.

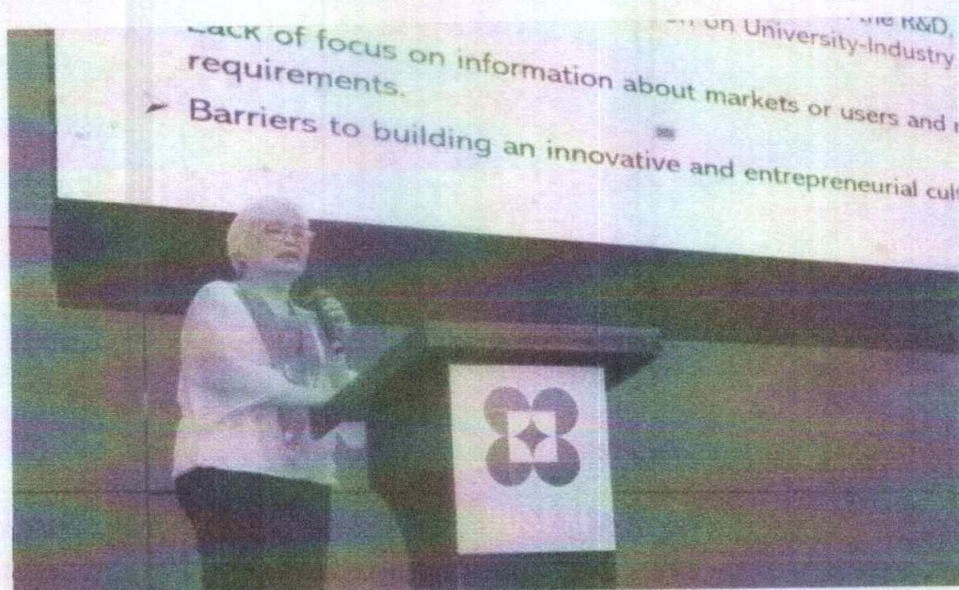

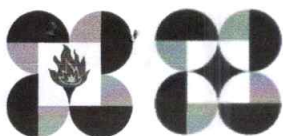


Exhibit Area



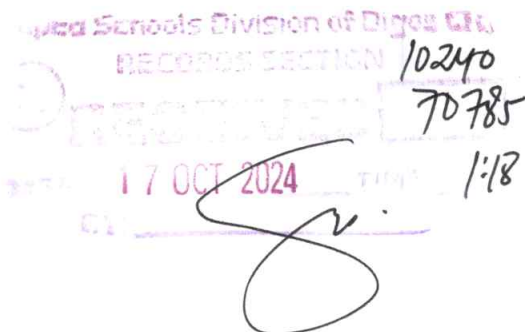

In light of increasing global challenges, the need for sustainable scientific innovations has become more critical than ever. To contribute to this effort, this school year's *Pakiglambigit* Program is again partnering with DOST XI on **November 12, 2024, from 8:00 to 5:00 PM, in Davao City**. The exact venue will be announced once it is finalized. This event is part of the **Regional Science, Technology, and Innovation Week (RSTW)** - Davao Region celebration from November 11-12, 2024.

The primary objective of this *Pakiglambigit* initiative is to empower teachers, and in turn, their students. 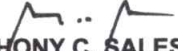
