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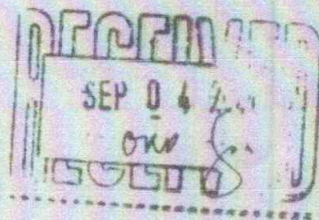

3.3.1 Resignation, Transfer, International Travel, and Retirement. In the event that the GRANTEE resigns, transfers, travels abroad or retires during the research implementation and failed to complete and submit the deliverables, the research proponent shall refund the total amount received. The Administrative Officer V of the Division Office shall ensure that the full amount received by the research from the Basic Education Research Fund must first be refunded prior to signing the clearance.
