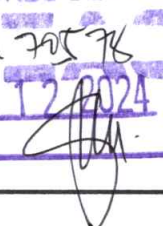
Furthermore, please be advised to bring boots or aqua shoes, empty rice sacks, black bags, an extra shirt and a refillable water bottle.

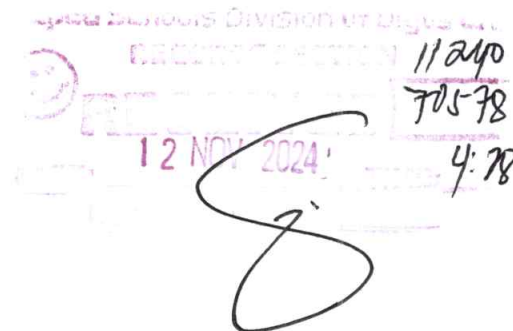
