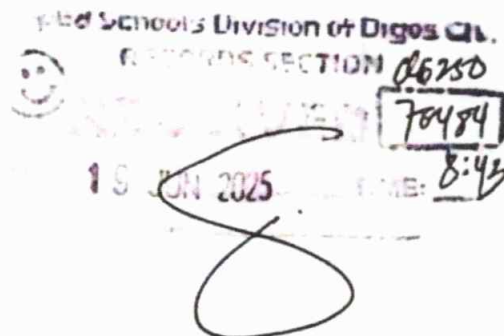

Madame:

In line with **DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2017** on “Policy and Guidelines on Healthy Food and Beverage Choices in Schools and DepEd Offices”, the DepEd Digos City Division recommends the **Dutch Mill Yoghurt Drink** to be sampled for Grades 1–4 during their Dutchmill School Tour Invasion Activity. This product have been carefully evaluated to ensure they adhere to the nutrition, safety, and categorization standards set by the Department of Education.

Dutch Mill yoghurt drink 90mL was subjected to the Nutrition Facts Assessment to ensure it falls within either the Green or Yellow category before implementation. Based on available nutrition label data of the 90 mL Dutch Mill yoghurt drink—the product's nutritional values approximate:

- Saturated fat:** approx. 0.5 g (Green threshold: < 3 g)
- Total sugar:** approx. 9 g (Green threshold: 10–20 g)
- Sodium:** 25 mg (Green threshold: < 120 mg)
- Trans fat:** 0
- Additional nutrients:** Contains proteins ($\approx$ 1 g), calcium ($\approx$ 78 mg), vitamins B1, B2, D and others

These metrics place Dutch Mill comfortably within the **Green category**, with saturated fat, sodium, and trans fat all well below the Green limits. Although sugar content slightly exceeds the ideal Green range (10 g), it remains near the lower end, and the overall nutrient profile—including calcium and B-vitamins—supports its acceptance under the policy. Its **Green-category** status ensures compliance with DepEd’s healthy school beverage standards. Please see the attached nutritional assessment report for comprehensive details.

The following product were subjected to evaluation:

EVALUATION METHODOLOGY

The evaluation process involved a thorough examination of the nutritional content, ingredients, and other relevant factors of each product. The criteria used for assessment were based on **Part V: PROCEDURES, Item A.1.h.** (Food products with Nutrition Facts shall be evaluated using the cut-off points for the three categories.) which is aligned with the dietary guidelines established in DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2017.

RECOMMENDATIONS

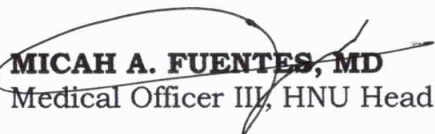
Based on the evaluation results, we recommend the following actions:
