In reference to Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Davao del Sur- Occidental Council Office Memorandum No. 8, s. 2026 dated February 9, 2026, the field is informed that the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Davao del Sur - Occidental Council will conduct ADVANCE TRAINING COURSE FOR LEADERS OF ADULTS on April 21 – 26, 2026 at Tribal Filipino School of Datalfitak, Brgy. Colonsabac, Matanao, Davao del Sur.

The following are the qualifications for the participants:

1. Registered with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines;
2. Maintain a state of physical and mental fitness as validated by a licensed physician. Failure to furnish a Medical Certificated may warrant disqualification to participate;
3. Have undergone and finished Basic Training Course: and
4. Serving as a Commissioner, Coordinator, Lay Leader, or Volunteer and must not be a Unit Leader.

A registration fee of five thousand pesos (Php. 5,000.00) shall be collected. This fee is intended to cover the cost of meals, training materials handouts and other incidental expenses necessary for the conduct of the training. Please note that the registration fee is non-refundable but transferable.

Payment must be made directly at the BSP Local Council Office not later than April 10, 2026. Onsite registration is not allowed, except for participants coming from other Local Councils.

Other details of the activity are found in the enclosures for ready reference.

Subject: **ADVANCED TRAINING COURSE FOR LEADERS OF ADULTS (WOODBADGE TRAINING)**

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Davao del Sur-Occidental Council is pleased to announce the conduct of **ADVANCED TRAINING COURSE FOR LEADERS OF ADULTS** on **April 21-26, 2026** at **Tribal Filipino School of Datalfitak, Brgy. Colonsabac, Matanao, Davao del Sur.**

2. **QUALIFICATIONS.** To qualify, a participating Scout Leader must be:

- Registered with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines;
- Maintain a state of physical and mental fitness as validated by a licensed physician. Failure to furnish a Medical Certificate may warrant disqualification to participate;
- Have undergone and finished Basic Training Course; and
- Serving as a Commissioner, Coordinator, Lay Leader, or Volunteer and must not be a Unit Leader;

3. **REGISTRATION DETAILS.** Stated below are the important details regarding the Jamboree Registration System and Procedure, viz:

- Registration Fee.** Participants are required to pay a Registration Fee of **FIVE THOUSAND PESOS ONLY (P5,000.00)**. This fee is intended to cover the costs of meals, training materials, handouts, and other incidental expenses necessary for the conduct of the training. Please note that the registration fee is non-refundable but transferable.
- Deadline.** Payment shall be made directly at the BSP Local Council Office not later than **April 10, 2026**. It should be noted that **onsite registration is not allowed**, except participants coming from other Local Councils.

To avoid any logistical issues and challenges in the planning and preparation of the training, participants must submit the payment with the corresponding Application Form and Medical Certificate which shall serve as proof and confirmation of participation.

4. **THINGS TO BRING.** Participants must bring the following to the training:

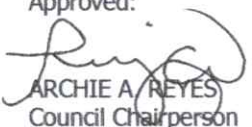
- Participants are expected to wear their **Type "A" Scout Uniform**, consisting of **short pants for male**, and **skirt for female**, **adult long socks with green garter tabs**, and **low-cut black leather shoes** with **shoelaces** (three to five holes);
- Clothes (sportswear and personal gears) appropriate for the whole duration of the training;
- Rubber shoes and Slippers;
- Jacket/Raincoat or Sweater for cold and rainy weather;
- Personal eating utensils (plates, spoon, fork, tumbler, mug, etc.);
- Toiletries;
- Writing materials for taking notes;
- Sleeping gears (tent with ply, blanket, sleeping bag, etc.)
- Filipiniana Attire for Socials;
- Other personal necessities (medicine, charger, money, etc.)

5. **FOOD PROVISION.** Meals starting dinner from April 20 to the last day of the training shall be handled by the Local Council. Any participant with food restriction must inform the Local Council or the Training Team prior to the start of the training.
6. **TRANSPORTATION.** Participants must arrange and manage their own transportation needs from their point of origin to the training site and vice versa.
7. **REPORTING DATE.** All participants must be present at the training venue by **3:00 PM** on **April 20, 2026** (a day before the first day of the training) and are expected to remain until the conclusion of the Closing Ceremony to take place on April 26, 2026.
8. All participating and serving DepEd Personnel shall be eligible to receive Service Credits and/or Compensatory Overtime Credits upon verification of all relevant paperwork.
