Preparations, coaching, travel, and other related activities shall not disrupt regular classes or require learners and teachers to be unnecessarily pulled out from instructional activities.

All interested schools shall comply with the Provisions and Safeguards Governing the Participation of Learners and Teachers in Non-DepEd Events and Activities, attached as Enclosure No. 1 to this Memorandum, particularly on parental consent, learner protection and safety, teacher supervision and authorization, travel arrangements, financial responsibilities, documentary requirements, and accountability of the School Head.

Interested schools may coordinate directly with the event organizer regarding registration, competition mechanics, fees, schedules, accommodation, and other pertinent details, subject to compliance with applicable DepEd policies and the provisions of this Memorandum.

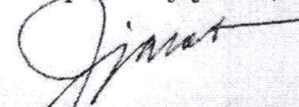
