Subject: **36TH REGIONAL CAMP OF THE GIRL SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES**

Date: August 12, 2026

In reference to GSP – Davao del Sur Girl Scout Council Circular No. 60, Series of 2026, this Office informs the field of the conduct of the 36th Regional Camp on September 10–13, 2026, at Energy Park, Tagum City, Davao del Norte, with the theme “RISE: Resilience Ignited with Service and Empowerment.”

The activity aims to provide Girl Scouts with a meaningful regional camping experience that will further develop their leadership, resilience, service orientation, self-reliance, teamwork, and empowerment, while providing opportunities to interact and build camaraderie with fellow Girl Scouts from across the Eastern Mindanao Region.

The registration fee is Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php3,500.00) per delegate, for both Girl Scouts and chaperons. The fee covers food, camp souvenirs, fare and entrance fees during off-site adventures, program and activity materials, pre-camp training expenses, gadgets, and food before and after the event, as well as transportation and other operational expenses for both girls and adults, as specified in the Council Circular.

Interested participants shall meet the following qualifications:

- must be a registered Girl Scout as of June 30, 2026;
- must be physically fit and submit a duly accomplished Health Declaration and Examination Form, signed by the participant and physician;
- must have attended a patrol pre-camp training; and
- each Junior Patrol shall have two (2) chaperons, while each Senior Patrol shall have one (1) chaperon, with each patrol composed of six (6) to eight (8) campers.

Participants are expected to arrive at the camp on September 10, 2026, with lunch as the first meal, and shall depart on September 13, 2026, after lunch.

In preparation for the activity, Pre-Camp Training shall be conducted on August 29, 2026, and September 5, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., at the GSP Conference Hall, Digos City. All concerned participants are advised to attend the required pre-camp training.

Participants shall bring the prescribed personal belongings, official and camp uniforms, hygiene and toiletry kits, sleeping materials, flashlight, eating utensils, personal medicines, mosquito repellent, and other necessary items. 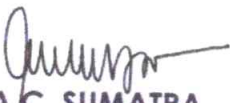

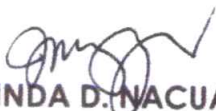
